DUBLIN



DAY 1 DUBLIN, IRELAND

Arrive at Dublin Airport and meet up with your driver for the transfer to your hotel. In the afternoon you'll embark on a foodie walking tour that covers 3 local pubs. You are free to spend the evening exploring on your own.

DAY 2 DUBLIN, IRELAND **MEALS:** Breakfast

After breakfast, enjoy a guided half-day walking tour of the Republic of Ireland's beautiful capital. Check out attractions like Trinity College and its magnificent Old Library, which houses the famous Book of Kells.

DAY 4 TRAVEL TO CORK, IRELAND **MEALS:** Breakfast, Dinner

En route on your journey to Cork, the next leg in your itinerary, you'll stop by Powerscourt Estate and Garden — one of Ireland's most beautiful gardens. Visit The Apple Farm for a tour and tasting. Dinner will be at Longueville House.

DAY 5 CORK, IRELAND **MEALS:** Breakfast

Enjoy a full-day excursion to County Tipperary — a landlocked rural area characterized by beautiful natural landscapes dotted with medieval buildings and Celtic ruins. Visit two notable cider houses during the trip.

OVERNIGHT: Jurys Inn or similar

DAY 6 TRAVEL TO KILLARNEY, IRELAND **MEALS:** Breakfast

Journey towards Killarney, a town set on the shores of Lough Leane and is a famous stop on the Ring of Kerry scenic drive. En route, you'll visit attractions like Blarney Castle, Blarney Woollen Mills, and a local smokehouse.

OVERNIGHT: Dromhall Hotel or similar

DAY 7 KILLARNEY, IRELAND **MEALS:** Breakfast, Snack

Take in several of Ireland's most dramatic scenery on a full-day Ring of Kerry tour. Admire white-sand beaches, majestic mountain passes, and charming villages. Stop at a local farmhouse to sample Gouda-type cheeses.

OVERNIGHT: Dromhall Hotel or similar

DAY 8 KILLARNEY, IRELAND **MEALS:** Breakfast, Dinner

Take advantage of the free morning to explore Killarney. In the afternoon, head to Bunratty Folk Park to check out its reconstruction of centuries-old traditional homes. In the evening, enjoy a medieval-style dinner at Knappogue Castle.

DAY 9 KILLARNEY, IRELAND **MEALS:** Breakfast

After breakfast, meet up with your driver for your transfer to Shannon Airport where you are scheduled to board your flight back to the United States.
